Letter of Commitment 2018-2019

This document outlines the commitments of a member of the Competitive Team.

Dancer Obligations:

I agree to attend my technique-required classes each week. I acknowledge that technique is an important component of my performance training.

I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to attend competitive classes on a regular basis. I acknowledge that instructors have been asked to strictly enforce the “three strikes” rule, whereby any student missing more than three classes may be penalized or taken out of a dance unless it is approved by the director. No refunds will be provided for missed classes.

I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to meet these attendance requirements and that I will not ask the Director and/or teachers to make exceptions (unless emergency or discussed with parent/guardian and approved).

I agree to come to class on time, in proper attire and footwear, including hair pulled back completely off of my face and with a positive attitude. I agree that I will behave appropriately in the classroom and acknowledge that competitive classes are hard work and require that I give the instructor my complete attention at all times.

I agree to practice skills and choreography at home as directed by the teachers.

I acknowledge that electronic devices (e.g. phones, cameras, laptops) are not permitted during practices. Teachers reserve the right to take these devices away from students until the end of class.

I acknowledge that instructors may use a recording device to film practices as part of the training program. I agree that any slander towards the competition team, studio, staff, students or volunteers will not be tolerated this includes posts and interaction on **social media**. If proven that this was done I acknowledge that I will be asked to leave the program with no refund. NO EXCEPTIONS. It is important that I remember this is a team and something that should be fun. It's not about competing against each other it's about working together and supporting each other. Putting others down will have serious consequences and not a member that will be allowed to represent Oui Dance.

I agree to attend any and all competitions the Director chooses to attend. In 2018-2019, the competitions will be discussed; options so far:

I agree that I will behave appropriately and in a sportsmanlike manner, as a member of Oui dance competition team, at all competitions.

Parent/Guardian Obligations

I acknowledge that I am required to pay competitive class instruction fees, costume fees and competition entry fees. I agree to pay these fees either in whole, or through a mutually acceptable payment plan negotiated with the Director. Final payment for class fees and competition entry fees and costumes are due no later than specific dates specified by director. Payment in full is required for the entire month unless another payment plan is discussed and approved individually to you by director.

All checks made payable to **Oui Dance**

I acknowledge that it is important for my dancer to attend class, be on time for each class and attend all three competitions identified above. I acknowledge that the “three strikes” rule will be enforced, meaning that any dancer missing more than three technique or competitive classes will be penalized, without any refund issued, unless authorized acceptable case scenarios.

I acknowledge that dancers may be asked to leave the competitive program, without any refund issued, due to persistent behavior or attitude problems, which may include: inattention during class, lack of respect for teacher/teammates, any negative social media slander, unsportsmanlike conduct or lack of effort at practice and competitions.

I acknowledge that instructors or members of the competition team may use a recording device to film practices as part of the training program. These recordings will not be shared with anyone external to the Oui Dance Competition Team. I further acknowledge that I will raise any safety concerns related to the filming of my child by October 31, 2017.

I acknowledge that competitions are sometimes run on school days/nights and it

may be necessary for my child to miss a half day or more of school to participate (rare). I further acknowledge that competition organizers do not issue schedules until 1-2 weeks in advance of the event.

I agree to remain with my child during competitions to ensure my child is properly supervised at all times. (Or notify the director if leaving the child in care of another parent/guardian).

I agree to ensure my child has all components of his/her competitive costumes at all competitions. This includes all pieces of each costume. Hairstyles and makeup requirements will be determined by instructors and communicated in advance of the first competition. The studio and director does not provide makeup or hair accessories (i.e. eye shadow, blush, bronzer, mascara, lipstick, curling irons, bobby pins, elastics, hair spray, hair gel, deodorant). Dancers are encouraged to purchase enough makeup and hair accessories for the entire season in advance of the first competition. (What makeup to purchase and how to apply and hair will be addressed and shown to new members).

We acknowledge that we have read and understand the information outlined above and agree to the obligations identified for dancers and parents/guardians.
